Parade Destaging Notes

PEDESTRIANS:

- QUICKLY MOVE TO SIDEWALKS AFTER REACHING END OF PARADE.
- DO NOT LOAD INTO VEHICLES WHILE IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROAD. MOVE TO SIDEWALK.
- BE MINDFUL OF MOVING VEHICLES.
 MOST HAVE BLIND SPOTS AND CAN'T SEE YOU.
- DO NOT SET
 EQUIPMENT/INSTRUMENTS IN THE
 MIDDLE OF THE ROAD.

Parade Destaging Notes

VEHICLES:

- MOVE SLOWLY THROUGH DE-STAGING.
 USE A GROUND GUIDE THROUGH CONGESTED AREAS!
- IF LOADING WALKERS INTO YOUR VEHICLE, PULL ALL THE WAY THROUGH THE END OF PARADE ROUTE AND TO ONE SIDE.
- DON'T BLOCK THE ROAD! THE PARADE CONTINUES BEHIND YOU AND QUICKLY BACKS UP.
- NEVER BACK UP WITHOUT A GROUND GUIDE.

Important De-staging Safety Notes

New protective road barriers limit options for exiting the parade area.

Hazard: Pedestrians and Vehicles **congest** the road south of Indian School Road

Control Measures:

- Pedestrians:
 - Quickly move to sidewalks after reaching end of parade.
 - Do not load into vehicles while in the middle of the road. Move to sidewalk.
 - Be mindful of moving vehicles. Most have blind spots and can't see you.
 - Do not set equipment/instruments in the middle of the road.
- · Vehicles:
 - Move slowly through de-staging. Use a ground guide through congested areas!
 - If loading walkers into your vehicle, pull all the way through the end of parade route and to one side.
 - Don't block the road! The parade continues behind you and quickly backs up.
 - Never back up without a ground guide.




